

Prof. Jean Daniel Orthlieb

Jean-Daniel ORTHLIEB received his doctorate in Odontology (DDS) in 1978 in Marseille, France.

He was a post - graduate certified in Anthropology, in fixed Prosthodontic and in Occlusodontology. He received his "doctorate d'Université " - PHD - in 1990.

In 1993 he was associate-professor, Chairman of the Anatomy, Occlusion and Dysfunction department of the Faculty of Odontology of Marseille, Aix-Marseille University.

From 2007, he is Full Professor. From 2009, he is Vice dean of the faculty of Odontology of Marseille in charge of education.

He is associate-director of the dental clinic at the public hospital LaTimone in Marseille.

He was President of the French National College of Occlusodontology in 1995-96.

He is a member of the European Academy of Craniomandibular Disorders (EACD), member of the education Committee of EACD.

In 2008 is named Visiting professor of Donau University-Austria.

He is past-president of the International Academy of Advanced Interdisciplinary Dentistry (IAAID). He had published 4 books and more than 110 scientific papers about occlusion, TMD and Prosthodontic.
